

RULES AND REGULATIONS

A group tour is an exciting opportunity whether you are a frequent traveller or venturing from home for the first time. Though we want you to feel free and comfortable, there are certain Rules and Guidelines set to make your experience pleasurable. Adhering to these rules and Guidelines will not only enhance your enjoyment of the trip but also ensure safety of all participants.

GUIDELINES FOR INDIAN RAILWAYS

- You and your belongings are subject to security check at Railway Stations. The Indian Railways reserves the right not to allow an item or belonging during your journey if found objectionable in nature.
- Should you refuse to part with such belongings, Railway Checking Staff reserves the right to remove you from the train compartment and ban you for the journey totally without refund.

You are banned from carrying the following items in Railway Compartments

- Licensed / Unlicensed Weapons
- Explosives, Fireworks, Hazardous Materials, Chemicals, Inflammable Items
- Sharp Objects like Arrows, Darts, Knives, Blades etc
- Contraband Drugs, Alcohol, Cigarettes, *Sheesha*
- Chewing Gum & Candies
- Magic Markers, Spray Paints (Inflammable), Aerosol Cans (Inflammable)

Smoking / Drinking / Contraband Drugs / Smoking *Sheesha*

- Smoking, Drinking, Use of Contraband Drugs and Smoking *Sheesha* is completely prohibited in Train Compartments / Railway Stations. Please refrain from doing so even in toilets and at the door. If caught, it is punishable by law with jail sentence and / or fine. It can also result in legal action and/or fine against the entire group and ban on every individual of the group from travelling in Indian Railway in the future (period decided by Indian Railways and go up to life)

Loud Music / Watching Porn / Gambling

- Please refrain from playing loud music or watching objectionable content on internet or otherwise and Gambling. All these activities are punishable by Law with Jail sentence and / or fine.

GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

- Your belongings are 100% your responsibility at all times of the tour. Tour Managers of Travelhot are not responsible for loss or theft of any kind.
- Please be polite and courteous to fellow passengers / local people / government servants / hotel staff / drivers of transport vehicles
- Please do not interfere with the duties of Railway Staff / Tour Managers / Hoteliers / Drivers of Transport Vehicle / Traffic police and any other public servant on duty.
- Please do not disrupt any programme or activity. Please follow instructions given by Tour Manager and Local Guides. Local Guides are well aware of the local surroundings and their instructions are for your safety and well-being.
- Please maintain proper decorum and wear proper attire (both men and women) in religious places, monuments of national interest and conservative areas.
- Please do not engage in unsafe, illegal activities or offensive behaviour. It may result in expulsion from Train Compartment / Hotel / Transport Vehicle without refunds and replacement.
- Please do not urinate or defecate or spit in public places. There will be proper halts at regular intervals with proper facilities.
- Please do not deface, damage or misuse any hotel property or transport vehicles or equipment of adventure tourism. If discovered, charges will be applicable and will have to be settled on own account. Tour Managers of Travelhot shall not be responsible for the same.
- Do not distribute any printed material for marketing of any kind or conduct an unauthorized event, hold demonstrations or unauthorized public gatherings and, make speeches.
- Please do not create noise through gadgets etc. so as to disturb peace of fellow passengers. Hoteliers / Transport Company reserve the right to ask you to leave the premises in such case without refund or replacement.
- Please do not litter anywhere. Be responsible tourist
- Please do not enter restricted areas in any part of the tour or encourage anyone to do so under the pretext of a "friendly challenge". It can get you in serious trouble.
- In case you notice any irregular activities or misconduct during your tour, please report it to your Tour Manager. Please do not take any action by yourself.
- Hoteliers and Transporters understand that you are out for some fun. However, excessive consumption of alcohol or contraband drugs or *sheesha* in hotel premises or transport vehicles can be cause of ejection from the premises without refund and replacement.
- No person under the age of 25 years is permitted to consume alcohol. Proper Identity Card issued by the Indian Government (Pan Card / Driver's License / Voter's ID / Ration Card / Passport) are required for purchase of alcohol. Please also buy only from licensed shops. Refrain from buying local brews and spurious country liquors.
